

Terms of participation for GameDays 2018 from 7th to 8th November 2018 in Darmstadt

These terms and conditions govern the relationship between the participants of GameDays 2018 from 8 to 9 June 2018 in Darmstadt and the organizers Technical University of Darmstadt and Hessian Telemedia Technology Competence Center - htcc e.V., hereinafter referred to as "organizer". Deviating agreements are not valid.



1. Service description

1.1 The costs of participation include those mentioned in the description of the conference. The organizer reserves the right to replace announced speakers with other speakers. Necessary changes to the program are also the responsibility of the organizer for preserving the overall character of the conference theme.

1.2 If the realization of the conference is not possible because of force majeure, because of the prevention of speakers, because of disturbances at the venue, the participants will be informed immediately. The participation fees will be reimbursed in these cases. A claim for compensation for travel, accommodation, lost work and other costs is excluded for these cases.

2. Registration, payment

2.1 Registrations are accepted by the organizers via the form under <http://www.gamedays2018.de>. Participants will receive an invoice via e-mail as PDF after registration. The invoice amount is due immediately upon receipt of the invoice.

2.2 For reduced participation fees (pupils, students and trainees) proof must be provided on the day of the congress by presenting the student card / enrollment certificate.

2.3 Failure to show will result in the full participation fee.

3. Photo, film, picture- and sound - recordings

3.1 By participating in the conference, the participants expressly authorize the organizer to take photographs, film, picture-, sound- and other recordings. Also granted is a permission for publications in print, internet, radio, television and other media formats to be used free of charge.

3.2 Photographs, film, image-, sound- and other recordings as well as storage on electronic and digital media, etc. of the conference's content and of the event venue may only be carried out by the participants with the prior written consent of the organizer. Rights of third parties, in particular intellectual property, performance protection and copyright, must be strictly observed by the participants.

4. House rules

The participants declare to comply with the applicable house rules of the respective venue. There is no smoking in all rooms. Alcoholic beverages, narcotics and similar substances must not be carried, consumed or offered in the area of all conference rooms.

5. Liability

Unless otherwise stipulated in these conditions, the organizer is liable for damages for breach of contractual or extra-contractual obligations only in case of intent or gross negligence of his board members and employees. For intent or gross negligence of non-executive employees, however, he is liable only if he violates a material contractual obligation and thereby the achievement of the purpose of the contract is endangered. In these cases, the compensation of the participant is limited to the maximum amount of compensation for the typical foreseeable damage. Any further liability is excluded. In particular, the organizer is not liable for the correctness and

applicability of the content provided by the speakers. In particular, for consequential damages resulting from their use, liability is excluded. No guarantee is given that the materials created by the instructors (eg lectures / documents, etc.) do not violate the rights of third parties. In addition, liability of the organizer for actions of persons not commissioned by the organizer or actions of the participants is excluded.

6. Privacy
